On imposing final anti-dumping fees on dumping imports of Edam and Gouda Cheese of Dutch origin or imported from the Netherlands

The Minister of Trade and Industry, after reviewing law No. 161 for the year 1998 about protecting the national economy from consequences of harmful international trade practices and its bylaws and amendments, the report of the advisory committee that convened on 27/12/2021 and the memorandum of the Head of the Trade Remedies Sector dated 27/12/2021, has taken the following decisions:

Article 1

Imports of Edam and Gouda cheese of Dutch origin or imported from the Netherlands listed under Article No. No. 04069090 of the coordinated customs tariff are subject to final anti-dumping fees based on the attached table.

Article 2

The mentioned fees will be paid to account number $(9/450/88042/8)_{C}$) at the Central Bank of Egypt.

Article 3

This decision shall be published in the Official Gazette and will be effective for five years starting the next day of the date of its publishing in the Official Gazette.
